

Your journey to Hotel Finca El Cabrito CHECKLIST

Dear guests

THIS IS WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW: IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE ITINERARY

The journey to El Cabrito is still a small "adventure", because the Canary Island of La Gomera has no international airport and therefore cannot be flown to directly from Europe. All in all, you can expect the travel day to take about 12 hours. This checklist is intended to help you make your travel days pleasant and stress-free.

1. Travel route via Tenerife South Airport

You first arrive by plane on the neighbouring island of Tenerife (Tenerife South, Reina Sofia) and continue to the port of Los Cristianos, from there take the ferry to the port of San Sebastian on La Gomera (depending on the ferry, 50 minutes to 1 hour). Once the ferry arrives, you will then continue to El Cabrito on one of our boats (approx. 15 minute).

Please note: Some sure-footedness is required to board our boats and to disembark from the boats onto the pier.

Arriving and departing via Tenerife North Airport (Los Rodeos) means more elaborate organisation due to the long journey time to the port of Los Cristianos.

Flight booking information: The ferries between Tenerife and La Gomera currently only run 2 to 3 times a day. We recommend that you make sure when booking your flight that you can take the midday ferry between Tenerife and La Gomera on both the outward and return journeys. Please also note: In order to arrive stress-free, there should be about 2 hours between landing and departure of the ferry. For the return journey, a time window of 2 hours between the arrival of the ferry in Los Cristianos and the departure time also proves useful.

Please note in winter - boat traffic: From November to March the weather can be stormy and the sea choppy on some days. Therefore, for safety reasons, our boats to and from San Sebastian only operate from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm in winter.

Arrival with the evening ferry and departure with the early ferry is not possible.

In general, we recommend booking your flight to Tenerife as early as possible and your departure from Tenerife as late as possible. In case of unfavourable flight times, it is advisable and more relaxed to plan an overnight stay on Tenerife or La Gomera. We will be happy to send you hotel tips for an overnight stopover.

2. Transfer:



For the onward journey from the airport on Tenerife to the port Los Cristianos and from there by ship to San Sebastian de La Gomera (and back) you have two options:

a)

Transfer MESA: The bus company MESA will wait for you at the airport, take you and your fellow travellers to the to the ferry and hand out the ferry tickets. The same applies to the return journey. Self-organised transfer

Baggage claim: From the time the plane lands until you receive your luggage, you should expect a waiting time of 30 minutes.

Public bus or taxi: The bus journey time between Tenerife South Airport and Los Cristianos bus station is about 20 minutes. From there it is another 15 minutes walk to the ferry port. The journey time of a taxi is about 20 minutes. It costs about €30.

3. Boat transfer El Cabrito

Please let us know your exact flight times for arrival and departure by phone or email at least three days before your arrival, so that we can organise the ferry crossing between San Sebastian and El Cabrito.

If there are any changes to your arrival times on the day of travel, please call us again briefly so that we can adjust to the new times.

In the harbour of San Sebastian, our marineros will be waiting for you at one of our boats (see sketch of the harbour of San Sebastian in the appendix). If the crew is not at the pier or the gate to the pier is locked, please call El Cabrito.

Luggage: At the pier of El Cabrito we will take care of the transport of your luggage to your room.

4. By foot to El Cabrito:

If you prefer to arrive by foot or if the boat transfer between San Sebastian and El Cabrito is not possible, you can also walk from San Sebastian to El Cabrito during the day. The walk over the approx. 7 km long steep coast (approx. 200 m difference in altitude) takes about 2.5 hours and requires a certain level of fitness, sure-footedness (hiking boots, hiking poles) and a head for heights. You can leave your luggage with our marineros in any case: It will be transported to El Cabrito by the next available boat.
